Why we love it...

The Art's Seedless Desert Willow can be grown as a small tree or a large shrub. This tree is astonishingly cold hardy to ten below zero as well as heat tolerant. You will be hard-pressed to find a tree that blooms as often and as long as this one; the dark-pink flowers entice hummingbirds and humans alike during spring, summer, and fall.

An exceptional quality of the 'Art's Seedless' Desert Willow cultivar in comparison to the many others is that following its flowering, you will not find seedpods hanging on the tree or littering your landscape.



Lydia says: Plant this tree in a location with lots of sunshine for maximum blossoming!
