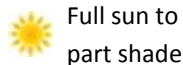
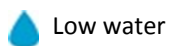




# ACACIA ANEURA

Search no further for the perfect poolside patio tree! Drought and heat tolerance, low litter production, and low maintenance requirements are among the most notable of Mulga's many alluring characteristics, making it an excellent choice for a variety of garden situations.

Slowly reaching a height of just 20 feet, this Australia native fits comfortably into any landscape or patio setting, while the dense evergreen canopy of grey-green foliage provides a stunning background or landscape foundation, and an attractive screen when planted in mass. Lemon-yellow flower rods beautifully compliment the silvery foliage in spring, after summer rains, and sporadically throughout the warm season.



**Lydia says:** Mulga trees are extremely drought tolerant! Keep them happy by making sure the soil is allowed to dry between watering.

### Evergreen Tree: *Acacia aneura*

**Size (H x W):** 15-20 feet x 12-15 feet

**Blooms:** Yellow, heaviest in spring

**Exposure:** Full Sun to part Shade

**Hardiness Zone:** 20° F, USDA Zone 8

**Water:** Low

**Pruning:** Minimal pruning in fall to shape

**Growth Rate:** Slow
