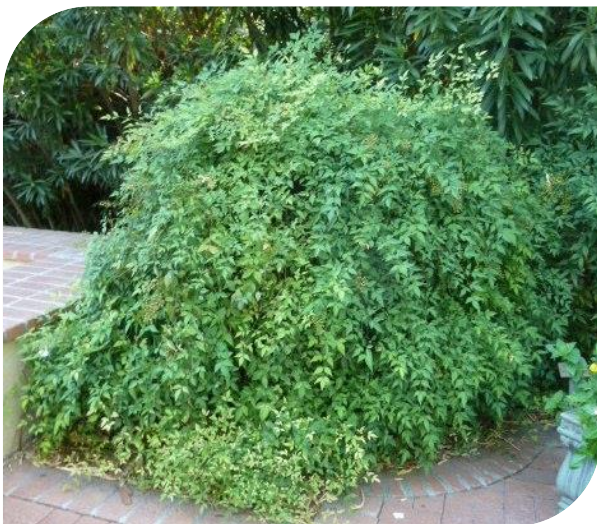

Heavenly Bamboo offers the graceful airiness of a true bamboo at only a fraction of the cost! This evergreen shrub contributes all kinds of seasonal interest to southwestern gardens with beautiful bronze to maroon leaf color in winter, clusters of white flowers from spring through summer, and ornamental red berries from summer to fall.

They create a nice effect in containers around pools and patios, where their penchant for cleanliness is a welcomed blessing. They also make a fine light and informal screen, hedge or space definer when grouped in the landscape. Virtually trouble-free, Heavenly Bamboo resists heat, drought, cold, pests and diseases with very little need for pruning or cleaning.



Lydia says: If your Heavenly Bamboo needs to be thinned, cut stems back at differing heights to preserve the shrub's attractive natural form.

Evergreen Shrub: *Nandina domestica*

Size (H x W): 4-7 feet x 3-4 feet

Blooms: Clusters of small white flowers in summer

Exposure: Full sun to part shade

Hardiness Zone: 0° F, USDA Zone 6

Water: Low to moderate

Pruning: Late winter to early spring

Growth Rate: Moderate to slow
