Pink Fairy Duster

-  Low to moderate water
-  Full sun to part shade
-  Attracts butterflies
-  Attracts hummingbirds
-  Rabbit resistant
-  Deer resistant
-  Native to Baja California

Why we love it...

Plant one of these low-maintenance beauties and forget about messy hummingbird feeders and sugar water! The red, feather-like plumes of the Baja Fairy Duster will have hummers visiting your garden from early spring through fall while furnishing your garden with color nearly year-round.

Exceptional heat and drought tolerance, ferny semi-evergreen foliage and the open, rounded form of this shrub make it a versatile choice; a perfect fit in natural landscapes, or as a specimen in the more manicured garden. For best results, provide this Baja California native with good drainage, at least 6 hours of full sun, and irrigate once a month.



Lydia says: You can encourage your Baja Fairy Duster to bloom more by removing the young seed pods while they are still green!

Semi-evergreen Shrub: *Calliandra eriophylla*

Size (H x W): 4-6 feet x 4-6 feet

Blooms: Red plumes, heaviest in spring and fall

Exposure: Full sun to part shade

Hardiness Zone: 20° F, USDA Zone 9

Water: Low to moderate

Pruning: Late spring to shape and remove winter damage
