



CALLIANDRA HYBRID 'MARICOPA RED'

Why we love it...

Plant one of these low-maintenance beauties and forget about messy hummingbird feeders and sugar water! The red, feather-like plumes of fairy duster will have hummers visiting your garden from early spring through fall while furnishing your garden with color nearly year-round.

Exceptional heat and drought tolerance, ferny semi-evergreen foliage and the open, rounded form of this shrub make it a versatile choice; a perfect fit in natural landscapes, or as a specimen in the more manicured garden. 'Maricopa Red' is a hybrid between the native and hardy pink fairy duster and the more tropical Baja fairy duster, resulting in a compact and cold tolerant fairy duster with vibrant red flowers. For best results, provide good drainage, at least 6 hours of full sun, and irrigate once a month.





Lydia says: You can encourage your fairy duster to bloom more by removing the young seed pods while they are still green!

Size (H x W): 3-4 feet x 3-4 feet

Blooms: Red plumes, heaviest in spring and fall

Exposure: Full sun to part shade

Hardiness Zone: 15° F, USDA Zone 8

Water: Low to moderate

Pruning: Late spring to shape and remove any

winter damage
